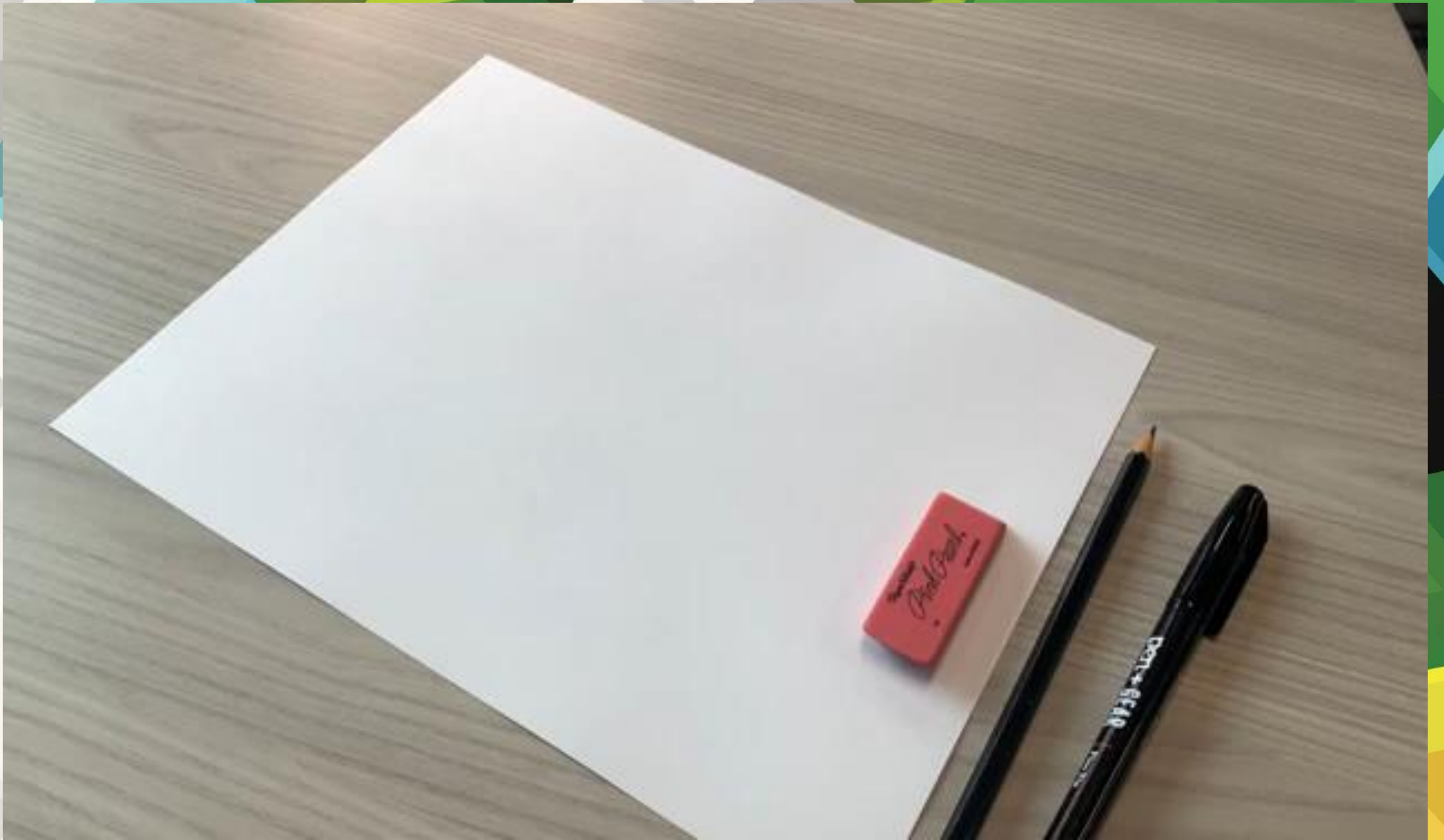

BUBBLE LETTERS

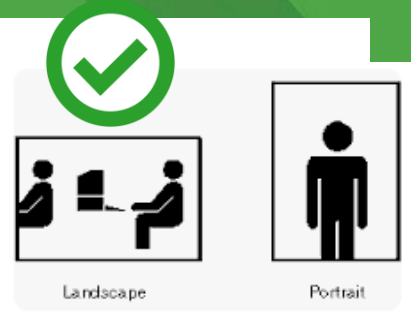
- 1) Lightly draw large letter.
- 2) Draw line all the way around the letter and inside (uniform width).
- 3) Optional: Erase inside line.



Bubble letter
examples

1. Write your name, nickname or initials (5 pts)
2. Using the paper in landscape position (5 pts)
3. Write the name using big letters. (5 pts)
 - a. Try to keep the letters spaced from one another.
4. Original inner lines not seen (5 pts)
 - a. Try not to press the pencil too much (since you must erase these later).
5. Make an extra border around the "bubble" letters (5 pts)
 - a. Try to always keep the line about the same distance from the center line.
